

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
OF THE TOWN OF MILO, MAINE --- June 3, 2013**

**TO:** Damien Pickel, Constable of the Town of Milo, in the County of Piscataquis, State of Maine:

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Milo in the County of Piscataquis and State of Maine, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Town Hall in Milo, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2013 in the evening at 6:00 PM to act on the following articles, to wit:

**ARTICLE 1**

To elect a Moderator to preside over this meeting.

**ARTICLE 2**

Public Hearing on CDBG funding proposal for Mike Anderson Milo Taxi Service.

**ARTICLE 3**

Shall the Town of Milo vote to approve a Community Development Block Grant application for the following program and dollar amount:

Program: 2013 Economic Development Program – Amount \$60,000

And to submit same to the Maine Department of Economic and Community Development and, if said program is approved, to authorize the municipal officers to accept said grant funds, to make such assurances, assume such responsibilities, and exercise such authorities as are necessary and reasonable to implement such programs and,

Furthermore, that the Town of Milo is cognizant of the requirement that, should the intended National Objective of the CDBG program not be met, all CDBG funds must be repaid to the State of Maine CDBG program.

**ARTICLE 4**

Shall the Town Milo vote to approve the Purchase and Sales Agreement for Lot 16, including the barns at the Eastern Piscataquis Business Park, along with the former trailer lot adjoining Lot 16, to Ronald and Amy Desmarais, dba: Eastern Maine Shooting Supplies, Inc., specifying a price of \$60,000, plus other considerations.

## **ARTICLE 5**

Shall the Town of Milo vote to approve the sale of Eastern Piscataquis Business Park Lot 17, to Tom and Nancy Harrigan, for new construction of a 30' x 120' building intended to be the future home of the Three Rivers Kiwanis Club of Milo/Brownville, specifying a price of \$1.00 provided that the Kiwanis Club obtain a 501 (C)(3) tax exempt status within one year of sale, plus other considerations.

## **ARTICLE 6**

Shall the Town of Milo vote to appropriate and authorize the use of funds received from sale of the property at the Eastern Piscataquis Business Park for the continued development of the Business Park.

## **ARTICLE 7**

Shall the Town of Milo vote to approve the donation of a narrow strip of land to MDOT for Route 11 Right of Way in return for the construction by MDOT of a Route 11 turn lane to enter the Eastern Piscataquis Business Park Access Road.

## **ARTICLE 8**

Shall the Town of Milo vote to approve the use of Milo Public Works Department labor and equipment as an in-kind match for the construction of the proposed Sebec River Carry Off Boat Launch Facility, to include 1,600 lineal feet of roadway, a parking area, a pathway to the river and a launch ramp.

## **ARTICLE 9**

Shall the Town of Milo appropriate and authorize \$279 for use by the Devils Sledders Snowmobile Club (Snowgrooming Tax Reimbursement).

## **ARTICLE 10**

Shall the Town of Milo vote to approve the Purchase and Sales Agreement for Lot 40, to the Milo Fire Department for use as a Fire Safety Training Center, specifying a price of \$1.00 on the basis that the Milo Fire Department is a Municipal Tax Exempt organization.

## **ARTICLE 11**

Shall the Town of Milo authorize submittal of a grant application to Stephen & Tabitha King Foundation for a \$50,000 grant for the construction of a Fire Safety Training Facility to be located on Lot 40 in the Eastern Piscataquis Business Park, and if awarded to appropriate and expend the funding from such grant for the stated purpose.

**ARTICLE 12**

Shall the Town of Milo appropriate and authorize from surplus the sum of \$4,000 to pay a portion of the cost of demolition and property clean-up for the Town owned, tax acquired, derelict property located at 6 Clinton Street.

**ARTICLE 13**


Brief Presentation by Town Manager regarding Penquis Solid Waste Landfill closure and establishment of a Transfer Station.
