

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE TOWN OF MILO, MAINE --- May 7, 2013**

TO: Damien Pickel, Constable of the Town of Milo, in the County of Piscataquis, State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Milo in the County of Piscataquis and State of Maine, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Town Hall in Milo, on the 7th day of May, 2013 in the evening at 6:00 PM to act on the following articles, to wit:

ARTICLE 1

To elect a Moderator to preside over this meeting.

ARTICLE 2

To Consider whether the Voters will Approve Appropriation from the Cemetery Trust Fund Earnings an Amount not to exceed \$6,500 for the Purchase of a Zero Turn Lawn Mower.

ARTICLE 3

To Consider whether the voters will Approve the Financing of \$26,000 for the purchase of a Police Cruiser that was Discussed and Approved as Part of the Budget at the Annual Town Meeting of March 11, 2013.

ARTICLE 4

To Consider whether the voters will Approve the Acceptance of Grant Funding for, and the Construction of, the MDOT Main Street "Safe Streets" Project. This item includes a Public Hearing on the Final Plans as prepared to go out to bid on May 8, 2013, if approved at this Special Town Meeting. The total funding amount is currently \$559,000, with additional funding pending, as needed, to complete the project.

ARTICLE 5

To Approve the Acceptance of EDI grants from 2008 to be used for the costs of various projects already completed at, or in conjunction with, the Eastern Piscataquis Industrial Park, to include construction of the proposed Access Road and Intersection Improvements Project, along with accepting any additional funding provided by MDOT for this work. The two grant amounts were \$198,000.00 and \$346,500.00 at time of grant agreements signed January 18, 2008.
