Milo and Brownville Recreation Departments are pleased to be providing area youth with an opportunity for ice skating again in 2012 ! The skating rink is cleared as soon as possible after a snowstorm. It will be resurfaced as needed.

Skating is at your own risk and no supervision is provided.

Currently the rink is in excellent condition !

The rink is the frozen pond off outer Park Street in Milo where in warmer weather trout have been stocked for fishing fun for area youth. The pond is NOT OPEN for ice fishing. Obviously holes in the ice is not conducive to safe skating or sliding and especially puts our smaller children in jeopardy.

Directions to the rink:

- Turn off Park Street onto Pit Road which is the road near the Industrial Park sign.
- Just before the fence and gate on Pit Road turn left and continue on the dirt road along the fence.
- Parking for the rink is about 300 yards down the dirt road.
